## 1. Introduction

ABC 21 aims to increase the energy performance, the quality of life and sustainability of West-African buildings through the identification, strengthening and effective deployment of affordable bioclimatic designs and local materials under the challenging African climate and urbanization context.

The key element of the project is the Africa-EU exchange and cooperation with the aim to create the conditions for a wave of policy initiatives on low-cost and effective bioclimatic constructions involving the nations that are partners of ABC 21, the nations inspired by UN-Habitat forums, and the nations influenced by allies of ABC 21.

Through existing connections of consortium partners ABC 21 and new information from our allies, ABC 21 is gathering a group of policy makers, construction builders, material producers and other actors in North West Africa and Europe. This document gives an overview of the main stakeholders and lists all of them in Annex A. The stakeholder list is an internal working document which will be adapted throughout the project. This deliverable indicates the status of January 2021.

### 1.1 Relation with other project activities

These stakeholders are a source for ABC 21 to gain support in the development of all WP2, WP3, WP4, in the collection of relevant information and in the dissemination and exploitation of results.

In WP2 they are a potential to provide information in order to identify and describe construction scenarios (e.g. rural, ongoing urbanization, materials...), the regulatory infrastructure and the policies supporting passive and bioclimatic approach adopted in Africa and EU.

In WP3 they allies will contribute to draw a picture of best practices for the application of bioclimatic design, passive techniques and use of local materials. In the early stages, they will support the identification of a set of bioclimatic indicators based on the use of appropriate nomenclature and definitions according to international standards as a necessary basis for effective design work and its communication.

WP4 is dedicated to exchange for policy support and market uptake: policy-makers, local construction builders, material producers and other actors will be identified. Sessions on needs and opportunities with the allies will also contribute to map important actors.

Workshop sessions and webinars with all actors, including allies, will help to gather the experiences so far, in order to complete the guidelines containing the policy proposal.

## 2. The main stakeholders

### 2.1 Policy Makers

## 2.2 Construction builders

### Eco-Dome - Morocco

Using a mixture made from 90 % earth and 10 % cement, each construction takes the shape of a dome. Both environmentally friendly and resistant to natural disasters, these houses cost less than reinforced concrete alternatives. The advantages of these domed houses are multiple: they are soundproof and offer thermal insulation, as well as reduced CO<sub>2</sub> emissions of up to 64 %. Construction time is also reduced.
